each year, and had a produce stand where we sold farm-fresh fruits and vegetables to the community. That has continued to mold who I am today."

Their Farmers Market inventory is now grown all over, she explains, with produce from Cooksville, China Grove, Mount Ulla, Lawndale, Lincoln County, and from right there in Sherrills Ford.

"We just started selling grass-fed beef from Catawba County, and we sell local coffee from Mooresville Black Powder, which is a very popular item!" says Tonya. "We've also picked up Pies and Sides out of Mt. Holly, and the very popular Hershey's ice cream."
